Ruler and Template Work for Domestic Machine Quilters

Skills, Equipment & Supplies Required for Class

- Basic Free Motion Quilting Skills Some free motion quilting experience is needed; this is not a beginning free motion class. However, you don't need to be highly skilled, just able to set your machine up for free motion quilting, do some stitching, and be safe enough to avoid running over your fingers or the ruler.
- Sew Steady Free Motion Quilting Ruler Foot Starter Kit This kit includes a ruler foot and straight/curved ruler. Be sure to purchase the ruler foot starter kit that is designed to fit your machine. (*Starter Kits will be available for purchase at Odegaard's Sewing Center. Contact them ahead of time with your machine make and model to purchase or reserve your Ruler Foot Starter Kit.)
- Sew Steady Sampler Template Set 1 We will utilize templates from the Sampler Template Set 1 including: 6" Spiral, Spin-e-fex No. 4, Spinning Wheel No. 36, 4" Arc, Clamshells and 2" Inside Circle in class. (*Sampler Sets and other additional templates are also available for purchase at Odegaard's Sewing Center.)
- Extension Table for Your Machine Ruler and template work requires a flat surface that is level with the bed of your machine and extends at least 6" from the needle in every direction. A "Sew Steady Extension Table" works well, or if you have a portable sewing table, i.e. an Arrow Gidget or SewEzi sewing table fitted to your machine with an acrylic insert, that will also work nicely. Any setup that provides a smooth flat surface around the bed of the machine will work.
- □ <u>3 4 Solid Color Fat Quarter Quilt Sandwiches</u> basted securely using 505 spray or other basting method of your choice. Please use a fairly dense, stable batting like Warm \$ Natural or Soft \$ Bright.
- D <u>Machine Quilting Thread</u> Choose thread colors that have some contrast to your fabric sandwiches for visibility.
- Hera Marker and/or Removable Fabric Marker that will be visible for marking placement lines on your fabric sandwiches, i.e. Chubby Crayon by Miracle Chalk or other iron-off marker, air-erase purple marker, water soluble blue marker, or Sewline or Bohin mechanical pencil with ceramic chalk leads.
- □ <u>12 18" Rotary Cutting Ruler</u> with 45 degree line for marking placement lines.
- □ <u>Scissors</u> for thread trimming.
- D <u>Supreme Slider</u> (optional but recommended) Free-Motion Slider or other similar teflon slider.
- D Free-Motion Quilting Gloves or other method of gripping the quilt sandwich (optional but recommended).
- □ OPTIONAL: <u>Purple Thang</u> for gauging ¼" spacing (Newer Ruler Foot Starter Kits come with a spacing gauge; check to see if you got one with your kit.)
- □ OPTIONAL: <u>Omnigrid Glow-Line Tape</u> for temporarily marking placement on rulers \$ templates.
- OPTIONAL for Sampler Pack template usage: <u>Scotch Tape</u> for use with templates that have removable "key holes".
