Kit Fee: \$20, to be paid to the instructor for a small prepared panel that is sandwiched and ready to quilt utilizing your new skills during the afternoon portion of this class.

Skills, Equipment & Supplies Required for Class

- Basic Free Motion Quilting Skills - Some free motion quilting experience is needed; this is not a beginning free motion class. However, you don't need to be highly skilled, just able to set your machine up for free motion quilting, do some stitching, and have enough control to be safe. Practicing background work is a great way to enhance your free motion quilting skills. Sewing machine set up for free motioning with a free motion foot .
- Walking Foot - for your machine.
- Extension Table for Your Machine - A "Sew Steady Extension Table" works well, or if you have a portable sewing table, i.e. an Arrow Gidget or SewEzi sewing table fitted to your machine with an acrylic insert, that will also work nicely. Any setup that provides a smooth flat surface around the bed of the machine will work for free motion quilting.
- Your favorite free motion quilting supplies - i.e. Machingers gloves, Supreme Slider mat, water or air soluble markers or other removable marking markers/pencils, etc.
- Basic sewing kit - including thread trimming scissors
- Rotary Cutting Ruler - at least 12" long with 45 and 60 degree markings.
- Several Solid Color or Tone-on-Tone Practice Quilt Sandwiches - measuring at least 12" x 12".
- Machine Quilting Threads - a selection of machine quilting threads to blend and to contrast with your sample sandwiches.
- Machine Quilting Needles - of appropriate sizes for your threads; extra bobbins.
